- g) Discuss Tier II Reporting Requirements for Mineral Oil
 - Anne Carlton, representative from Arizona Public Service, speaking of APS's protocols for Tier II reporting and SDS sharing for mineral oil. Wanted LEPC's input/feedback if they should continue to submit electronic reports pertaining to Mineral Oil exposure, several agencies are overwhelmed by the numerous reports. ADEQ nor the LEPC cannot waive these requirements, perhaps AzSERC- suggested by Brian Hickey.
