CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM NEWS – April 2010

Adult Incarceration

Bookings decreased from 10,227 in March to 10,075 in April. The **Average Daily Population increased** from 7,822 in March to 7,938 in April. The **Pretrial Population increased** in April (5,453) compared to March (5,416). The **Sentenced Population increased** from 2,043 in March to 2,138 in April. The **Agency Hold Population decreased** from 307 in March to 294 in April. **Overall Average Length of Stay (ALOS) decreased** from 27 days in March to 24 in April. **The ALOS for Sentenced decreased** from 24.4 to 22.6 days, while the **Pretrial ALOS decreased** from 6.4 to 5.7 days. **The ALOS for Agency Holds decreased** from 69.5 to 59.8 days.

Superior Court Filings & Case Processing

Criminal Filings decreased from March (3,274) to April (2,743). **Terminations increased slightly** from 3,147 in March to 3,155 in April. The resulting **Clearance Rate** was 115%. The **Active Pending Case Inventory decreased** from 11,035 in March to 10,934 in April. **Filings into RCC decreased** in April (1,662) compared to March (1,946). **Filings into EDC decreased** from 1,074 in March to 891 in April. **The Number of Trials Completed decreased** from 71 in March to 62 in April. **The Trial Rate** was 2.3%.

Justice Court Filings

DUI Filings decreased slightly from March (845) to April (838). All other **Criminal Traffic Filings decreased** from 4,244 in March to 3,759 in April. **Civil Traffic Filings decreased** from 12,281 in March to 10,889 in April. **Civil Traffic Photo Enforcement Filings decreased** from 33,081 in March to 29,359 in April. **Eviction Action Filings increased** from March (4,294) to April (4,651). **Overall Filings increased** from 66,111 in March to 61,337 in April.


Adult Probation

Pretrial General Supervision decreased from March (595) to April (570). **Pretrial Intensive Supervision decreased** from 863 in March to 850 in April. **Electronic Monitoring decreased slightly** from 228 in March to 215 in April. **Levels of Standard Probation Supervision decreased** from 30,478 in March to 30,368 in April. **Levels of Intensive Probation Supervision increased** from 787 in March to 804 in April.


Juvenile Detention and Probation

The **Average Daily Detention Population increased slightly** from 262 in March to 266 in April. **ALOS increased** from 13.1 to 15.1 days. **Commitments to the Arizona Department of Juvenile Corrections decreased** from 50 in March to 39 in April. **Standard probation decreased** from 4,082 in March to 4,028 in April. **Intensive Probation increased** from 358 in March to 373 in April.




Average Daily Jail Population




Average Daily Jail Population by Type



Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail




Average Length of Stay in Jail for Agency Holds




Average Length of Stay in Jail Pretrial vs Sentenced Population



Average Length of Stay in Jail for Pretrial Inmates




Sheriff's Office Transports for Inmate Court Appearances






Active Pending Criminal Case Inventory

Cases Arraigned




Direct Complaints into Superior Court




Status of Cases After 180 Days

Disposition of Cases Terminated


Average Monthly Dispositions by Quarter






Grand Jury Indictments





Average Monthly Filings by Quarter




Pretrial Supervision Defendant Monitoring Unit



Pretrial Supervision Defendants on Electronic Monitoring




Adult Probation Standard Supervision Population



Adult Probation Intensive Supervision Population




Juvenile Detention Average Daily Population

Juvenile Detention Average Length of Stay


