CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM NEWS – April 2011

Adult Incarceration

Bookings decreased from 9,548 in March to 9,173 in April. The **Average Daily Population increased** from 7,181 in March to 7,416 in April. The **Pretrial Population increased** in April (5,061) compared to March (4,929). The **Sentenced Population increased** from 1,961 in March to 1,975 in April. The **Agency Hold Population increased** from 239 in March to 327 in April. **Overall Average Length of Stay (ALOS) increased** from March (23.3) to April (24.3). **The ALOS for Sentenced increased** from 22.4 to 24.8 days, while the **Pretrial ALOS decreased** from 6.9 to 6.4 days. The **ALOS for Agency Holds increased** from 60 to 63 days.

Superior Court Filings & Case Processing

Criminal Filings increased from March (2,937) to April (2,962). **Terminations decreased** from 3,394 in March to 3,359 in April. The resulting **Clearance Rate** was 113%. The **Active Pending Case Inventory increased** from 10,031 in March to 10,284 in April. **Filings into RCC decreased** in April (1,567) compared to March (1,685). **Filings into EDC increased** from 976 in March to 1,127 in April. The **Number of Trials Completed stayed the same** with 58 in March and April. **The Trial Rate** was 2%.

Justice Court Filings

DUI Filings decreased from March (838) to April (730). All other **Criminal Traffic Filings decreased** from 4,105 in March to 3,722 in April. **Civil Traffic Filings increased** from 11,502 in March to 11,841 in April. **Eviction Action Filings increased** from March (4,181) to April (4,801). **Overall Filings decreased** from 32,037 in March to 31,840 in April.

Adult Probation


Pretrial General Supervision decreased from March (565) to April (554). **Pretrial Intensive Supervision increased** from 994 in March to 1,022 in April. **Electronic Monitoring increased slightly** from 212 in March to 218 in April. **Levels of Standard Probation Supervision increased** from 29,517 in March to 30,005 in April. **Levels of Intensive Probation Supervision decreased** from 812 in March to 796 in April.

Juvenile Detention and Probation


The **Average Daily Detention Population decreased** from 261 in March to 257 in April. **ALOS decreased** from 15.4 to 14.2 days. **Standard probation decreased** from 3,386 in March to 3,324 in April. **Intensive Probation decreased slightly** from 319 in March to 316 in April.


Jail Bookings




Average Daily Jail Population




Average Daily Jail Population by Type



Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail




Average Length of Stay in Jail for Agency Holds




Average Length of Stay in Jail Pretrial vs Sentenced Population



Average Length of Stay in Jail for Pretrial Inmates




Sheriff's Office Transports for Inmate Court Appearances








Active Pending Criminal Case Inventory

Cases Arraigned




Direct Complaints into Superior Court




Status of Cases After 180 Days

Disposition of Cases Terminated


Average Monthly Dispositions by Quarter






Grand Jury Indictments




Average Monthly Filings by Quarter




Pretrial Supervision Defendant Monitoring Unit



Pretrial Supervision Defendants on Electronic Monitoring




Adult Probation Standard Supervision Population



Adult Probation Intensive Supervision Population




Juvenile Detention Average Daily Population



Revised FY08 results based on adjustments in iCIS reporting.


Juvenile Detention Average Length of Stay
