## *CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM NEWS – December 2010*

### Adult Incarceration

**Bookings decreased** from 8,453 in November to 8,154 in December. The **Average Daily Population decreased** from 7,263 in November to 6,854 in December. The **Pretrial Population decreased** in December (4,641) compared to November (4,910). The **Sentenced Population decreased** from 2,089 in November to 1,753 in December. The **Agency Hold Population decreased slightly** from 219 in November to 199 in December. **Overall Average Length of Stay (ALOS) decreased slightly** from November (26.1) to December (25.9). **The ALOS for Sentenced increased** from 25.3 to 27.4 days, while the **Pretrial ALOS increased** from 6.3 to 7.3 days. The **ALOS for Agency Holds increased** from 65.6 to 67.3 days.

### Superior Court Filings & Case Processing

**Criminal Filings increased slightly** from November (2,620) to December (2,635). **Terminations decreased** from 2,837 in November to 2,231 in December. The resulting **Clearance Rate** was 84.7%. The **Active Pending Case Inventory increased** from 9,799 in November to 10,410 in December. **Filings into RCC increased** in December (1,595) compared to November (1,502). **Filings into EDC decreased** from 885 in November to 802 in December. The **Number of Trials Completed decreased** from 49 in November to 26 in December. **The Trial Rate** was 1%.

### Justice Court Filings

**DUI Filings increased greatly** from November (693) to December (1,223). All other **Criminal Traffic Filings increased** from 3,247 in November to 3,844 in December. **Civil Traffic Filings increased** from 10,351 in November to 11,146 in December. **Eviction Action Filings increased** from November (4,863) to December (5,078). **Overall Filings increased** from 29,388 in November to 32,220 in December.


### Adult Probation

**Pretrial General Supervision increased** from November (565) to December (595). **Pretrial Intensive Supervision increased slightly** from 765 in November to 767 in December. **Electronic Monitoring decreased slightly** from 194 in November to 191 in December. **Levels of Standard Probation Supervision decreased** from 30,701 in November to 30,293 in December. **Levels of Intensive Probation Supervision increased slightly** from 792 in November to 799 in December.


### Juvenile Detention and Probation

The **Average Daily Detention Population decreased** from 246 in November to 219 in December. **ALOS increased** from 12.7 to 14.6 days. **Commitments to the Arizona Department of Juvenile Corrections increased** from 38 in November to 45 in December. **Standard probation decreased** from 3,617 in November to 3,533 in December. **Intensive Probation increased slightly** from 319 in November to 320 in December.




# Average Daily Jail Population




# Average Daily Jail Population by Type



# Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail




# Average Length of Stay in Jail for Agency Holds




# Average Length of Stay in Jail Pretrial vs Sentenced Population



# Average Length of Stay in Jail for Pretrial Inmates




# Sheriff's Office Transports for Inmate Court Appearances








# Active Pending Criminal Case Inventory

Cases Arraigned




# Direct Complaints into Superior Court




# Status of Cases After 180 Days

# Disposition of Cases Terminated


Average Monthly Dispositions by Quarter






# Grand Jury Indictments




## Average Monthly Filings by Quarter




# Pretrial Supervision Defendant Monitoring Unit



# Pretrial Supervision Defendants on Electronic Monitoring




# Adult Probation Standard Supervision Population



# Adult Probation Intensive Supervision Population




# Juvenile Detention Average Daily Population

# Juvenile Detention Average Length of Stay


