CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM NEWS – February 2010

Adult Incarceration

Bookings decreased from 10,229 in January to 9,167 in February. The **Average Daily Population increased** from 7,777 in January to 7,835 in February. The **Pretrial Population increased** in February (5,466) compared to January (5,456). The **Sentenced Population increased** from 1,980 in January to 2,030 in February. The **Agency Hold Population decreased slightly** from 289 in January to 282 in February. **Overall Average Length of Stay (ALOS) decreased slightly** from 24.4 days in January to 23.9 in February. **The ALOS for Sentenced increased slightly** from 23.2 to 23.6 days, while the **Pretrial ALOS increased** from 6.0 to 7.0. The **ALOS for Agency Holds decreased** from 67.5 to 61.8 days.

Superior Court Filings & Case Processing

Criminal Filings increased from January (2,705) to February (2,855). **Terminations increased** from 2,638 in January to 2,767 in February. The resulting **Clearance Rate** was 96.9%. The **Active Pending Case Inventory decreased** from 11,603 in January to 10,989 in February. **Filings into RCC increased slightly** in February (1,635) compared to January (1,630). **Filings into EDC increased** from 825 in January to 1,004 in February. The **Number of Trials Completed increased slightly** from 65 in January to 66 in February. **The Trial Rate** was 2.3%.

Justice Court Filings

Eviction Action Filings decreased from January (5,497) to February (3,848). **Overall Filings** in December were 63,621 including 34,945 filings from Civil Traffic Photo Enforcement.


Adult Probation

Pretrial General Supervision increased slightly from January (539) to February (541). **Pretrial Intensive Supervision increased slightly** from 831 in January to 833 in February. **Electronic Monitoring decreased slightly** from 234 in January to 233 in February. **Levels of Standard Probation Supervision increased** from 30,452 in January to 30,654 in February. **Levels of Intensive Probation Supervision decreased** from 817 in January to 807 in February.


Juvenile Detention and Probation

The **Average Daily Detention Population increased** from 256 in January to 267 in February. **ALOS increased slightly** from 12.5 to 12.6 days. **Commitments to the Arizona Department of Juvenile Corrections increased** from 24 in January to 37 in February. **Standard probation decreased slightly** from 4,058 in January to 4,054 in February. **Intensive Probation decreased slightly** from 387 to 380.




Average Daily Jail Population




Average Daily Jail Population by Type



Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail




Average Length of Stay in Jail for Agency Holds




Average Length of Stay in Jail Pretrial vs Sentenced Population



Average Length of Stay in Jail for Pretrial Inmates




Sheriff's Office Transports for Inmate Court Appearances








Active Pending Criminal Case Inventory




Direct Complaints into Superior Court




Status of Cases After 180 Days

Disposition of Cases Terminated








Grand Jury Indictments




Justice Court Filings February 2010




Pretrial Supervision Defendant Monitoring Unit



Pretrial Supervision Defendants on Electronic Monitoring




Adult Probation Standard Supervision Population



Adult Probation Intensive Supervision Population




Juvenile Detention Average Daily Population

Juvenile Detention Average Length of Stay


