### *CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM NEWS – July 2009*

#### **Adult Incarceration**

**Bookings decreased** from 11,113 in June to 10,840 in July. The **Average Daily Population decreased** from 8,781 to 8,604. The **Pretrial Population decreased slightly** in July (6,000) compared to June (6,013). The **Sentenced Population decreased** from 2,391 in June to 2,204 in July. **Agency Hold Populations increased** from 317 in June to 345 in July. **Overall Average Length of Stay (ALOS) increased** from 24.9 days in June to 25.5 days in July. **The ALOS for Sentenced increased slightly** from 23.7 days to 24.9 days, while the **ALOS for Agency Holds decreased** from 60.8 to 57.7 days. **Pretrial ALOS increased** from 5.5 to 7.2 days.

#### **Superior Court Filings & Case Processing**

**Criminal Filings decreased** from June (3,395) to July (2,907). **Terminations decreased** to 2,658 in July from 2,914 in June. The resulting **Clearance Rate** was 91.4%. The **Active Pending Case Inventory increased** from 11,430 in June to 11,847 in July. **Filings into RCC decreased** in July (1,727) compared to June (2,089). **Filings into EDC decreased** from 1,035 in June to 966 in July. The **Number of Trials Completed increased slightly** from 58 in June to 62 in July. **The Trial Rate** was 2.1%.

#### **Justice Court Filings**

**Forcible Detainer Filings increased** from June (5,758) to July (6,243). **Overall Filings** in July were 86,410 including 50,192 filings from Civil Traffic Photo Enforcement.

#### **Adult Probation**

**Pretrial General Supervision increased** from June (528) to July (539). **Pretrial Intensive Supervision increased** from 961 in June to 980 in July. **Electronic Monitoring decreased** from 259 in June to 246 in July. Levels of **Standard Probation Supervision increased** from 29,239 in June to 29,618 in July. **Levels of Intensive Probation Supervision decreased** from 870 in June to 832 in July.


#### **Juvenile Detention and Probation**

The **Average Daily Detention Population (ADP) decreased** from 301 in June to 274 in July. **ALOS decreased slightly** from 14.9 to 14.7 days. **Commitments to ADJC increased slightly** from 47 in June to 53 in July. **Intensive Probation decreased** from 442 to 405. **Standard probation increased slightly** from 4,134 in June to 4,139 in July.






# Average Daily Jail Population




# Average Daily Jail Population by Type



# Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail




# Average Length of Stay in Jail for Agency Holds




# Average Length of Stay in Jail Pretrial vs Sentenced Population



# Average Length of Stay in Jail for Pretrial Inmates




# Sheriff's Office Transports for Inmate Court Appearances


# Superior Court Filings and Terminations

Direct Filing began in May 2002




# Active Pending Criminal Case Inventory

Cases Arraigned




# Direct Complaints into Superior Court




# Status of Cases After 180 Days

# Disposition of Cases Terminated








# Grand Jury Indictments






# Pretrial Supervision Defendant Monitoring Unit



# Pretrial Supervision Defendants on Electronic Monitoring




# Adult Probation Standard Supervision Population



# Adult Probation Intensive Supervision Population




# Juvenile Detention Average Daily Population

# Juvenile Detention Average Length of Stay


