CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM NEWS – July 2010

Adult Incarceration

Bookings decreased from 9,944 in June to 9,732 in July. The **Average Daily Population decreased** from 7,732 in June to 7,482 in July. The **Pretrial Population decreased** in July (5,165) compared to June (5,278). The **Sentenced Population decreased** from 2,108 in June to 2,005 in July. The **Agency Hold Population decreased** from 289 in June to 261 in July. **Overall Average Length of Stay (ALOS) decreased slightly** from June (24) to July (23). **The ALOS for Sentenced decreased slightly** from 24.9 to 24.7 days, while the **Pretrial ALOS decreased slightly** from 5.8 to 5.5 days. **The ALOS for Agency Holds increased slightly** from 59 to 60 days.

Superior Court Filings & Case Processing

Criminal Filings decreased from June (3,082) to July (2,504). **Terminations decreased** from 2,891 in June to 2,809 in July. The resulting **Clearance Rate** was 112%. The **Active Pending Case Inventory decreased** from 10,439 in June to 10,225 in July. **Filings into RCC decreased** in July (1,557) compared to June (1,757). **Filings into EDC decreased** from 1,105 in June to 779 in July. **The Number of Trials Completed decreased slightly** from 52 in June to 51 in July. **The Trial Rate** was 2%.

Justice Court Filings

DUI Filings increased slightly from June (851) to July (858). All other **Criminal Traffic Filings decreased** from 4,250 in June to 3,808 in July. **Civil Traffic Filings decreased** from 12,991 in June to 10,324 in July. **Civil Traffic Photo Enforcement Filings increased** from 63,846 in June to 73,935 in July. **Eviction Action Filings increased** from June (5,595) to July (6,112). **Overall Filings increased** from 99,942 in June to 107,149 in July.


Adult Probation

Pretrial General Supervision stayed the same from June (559) to July (559). **Pretrial Intensive Supervision decreased** from 828 in June to 805 in July. **Electronic Monitoring decreased slightly** from 196 in June to 193 in July. **Levels of Standard Probation Supervision increased** from 30,228 in June to 30,575 in July. **Levels of Intensive Probation Supervision increased slightly** from 808 in June to 810 in July.


Juvenile Detention and Probation

The **Average Daily Detention Population decreased** from 263 in June to 245 in July. **ALOS decreased slightly** from 14.8 to 14.7 days. **Commitments to the Arizona Department of Juvenile Corrections decreased** from 31 in June to 27 in July. **Standard probation decreased** from 3,848 in June to 3,771 in July. **Intensive Probation decreased** from 373 in June to 370 in July.


Jail Bookings




Average Daily Jail Population




Average Daily Jail Population by Type



Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail




Average Length of Stay in Jail for Agency Holds




Average Length of Stay in Jail Pretrial vs Sentenced Population



Average Length of Stay in Jail for Pretrial Inmates




Sheriff's Office Transports for Inmate Court Appearances








Active Pending Criminal Case Inventory

Cases Arraigned




Direct Complaints into Superior Court




Status of Cases After 180 Days

Active Awaiting sentence Terminated




Superior Court Trials Completed




Disposition of Cases Terminated

Average Monthly Dispositions by Quarter




Grand Jury Indictments




Average Monthly Filings by Quarter




Pretrial Supervision Defendant Monitoring Unit



Pretrial Supervision Defendants on Electronic Monitoring




Adult Probation Standard Supervision Population



Adult Probation Intensive Supervision Population




Juvenile Detention Average Daily Population

Juvenile Detention Average Length of Stay


