CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM NEWS – July 2011

Adult Incarceration

Bookings decreased from 9,217 in June to 9,001 in July. The **Average Daily Population decreased** from 7,526 in June to 7,330 in July. The **Pretrial Population decreased** from June (5,176) to July (5,148). The **Sentenced Population decreased** from 1,973 in June to 1,862 in July. The **Agency Hold Population decreased** from 322 in June to 261 in July. **Overall Average Length of Stay (ALOS) increased** from June (23.3) to July (24.5). **The ALOS for Sentenced increased** from 23 to 26 days, while the **Pretrial ALOS increased** from 5.8 to 7.5 days. The **ALOS for Agency Holds increased** from 59 to 62 days.

Superior Court Filings & Case Processing

Criminal Filings decreased from June (2,895) to July (2,648). **Terminations decreased** from 2,998 in June to 2,681 in July. The resulting **Clearance Rate** was 101%. The **Active Pending Case Inventory increased** from 10,238 in June to 10,358 in July. **Filings into RCC decreased** from June (1,546) to July (1,478). **Filings into EDC decreased** from 1,029 in June to 973 in July. The **Number of Trials Completed increased** from 26 in June to 45 in July. The **Trial Rate** was 1.7%.

Justice Court Filings

DUI Filings increased slightly from June (794) to July (799). All other **Criminal Traffic Filings decreased** from 4,077 in June to 3,290 in July. **Civil Traffic Filings decreased** from 12,081 in June to 10,266 in July. **Eviction Action Filings increased** from June (5,605) to July (6,004). **Overall Filings decreased** from 33,080 in June to 29,997 in July.

Adult Probation


Pretrial General Supervision decreased from June (574) to July (550). **Pretrial Intensive Supervision decreased** from 1,127 in June to 1,090 in July. **Electronic Monitoring increased** from 216 in June to 224 in July. **Levels of Standard Probation Supervision decreased** from 21,609 in June to 21,589 in July. **Levels of Intensive Probation Supervision decreased** from 784 in June to 771 in July. **Levels of Unsupervised Probation Supervision decreased** from 8,515 in June to 8,375 in July.

Juvenile Detention and Probation


The **Average Daily Detention Population decreased** from 230 in June to 213 in July. **ALOS decreased** from 14.9 to 11.9 days. **Standard probation decreased** from 3,233 in June to 3,119 in July. **Intensive Probation decreased** from 295 in June to 284 in July.


Jail Bookings




Average Daily Jail Population




Average Daily Jail Population by Type



Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail




Average Length of Stay in Jail for Agency Holds




Average Length of Stay in Jail Pretrial vs Sentenced Population



Average Length of Stay in Jail for Pretrial Inmates




Sheriff's Office Transports for Inmate Court Appearances








Active Pending Criminal Case Inventory

■ Cases Arraigned




Direct Complaints into Superior Court




Status of Cases After 180 Days

Disposition of Cases Terminated








Grand Jury Indictments


Justice Court Filings July 2011


Average Monthly Filings by Quarter




Pretrial Supervision Defendant Monitoring Unit



Pretrial Supervision Defendants on Electronic Monitoring




Adult Probation Standard Supervision Population



Adult Probation Intensive Supervision Population




Adult Probation Unsupervised Population


