## Criminal Justice System

### *CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM NEWS – June 2009*

#### **Adult Incarceration**

**Bookings decreased** from 11,293 in May to 11,113 in June. The **Average Daily Population decreased** from 8,862 to 8,781. The **Pretrial Population increased** in June (6,013) compared to May (5,976). The **Sentenced Population decreased** from 2,477 in May to 2,391 in June. **Agency Hold Populations decreased** from 352 in May to 317 in June. **Overall Average Length of Stay (ALOS) decreased** from 25.8 days in May to 24.9 days in June. **The ALOS for Sentenced increased slightly** from 23.1 to 23.7 days, while the **ALOS for Agency Holds decreased** from 64 to 60.8 days. **Pretrial ALOS decreased** from 6.6 to 5.5 days.

#### **Superior Court Filings & Case Processing**

**Criminal Filings increased** from May (2,984) to June (3,395). **Terminations decreased** to 2,914 in June from 2,967 in May. The resulting **Clearance Rate** was 85.8%. The **Active Pending Case Inventory increased** from 10,963 in May to 11,430 in June. **Filings into RCC increased** in June (2,089) compared to May (1,731). **Filings into EDC increased slightly** from 1,029 in May to 1,035 in June. The **Number of Trials Completed decreased** from 95 in May to 58 in June. **The Trial Rate** was 1.7%.

#### **Justice Court Filings**

**Forcible Detainer Filings increased** from May (5,397) to June (5,758). **Overall Filings increased** from May (31,745) to June (36,727).

#### **Adult Probation**

**Pretrial General Supervision decreased** from May (538) to June (528). **Pretrial Intensive Supervision decreased** from 987 in May to 961 in June. **Electronic Monitoring increased** from 252 in May to 259 in June. Levels of **Standard Probation Supervision increased** from 29,154 in May to 29,239 in June. **Levels of Intensive Probation Supervision decreased** from 897 in May to 870 in June.

#### **Juvenile Detention and Probation**

The **Average Daily Detention Population (ADP) increased slightly** from 289 in May to 301 in June. ADP is down 14% when comparing FY08 to FY09. **ALOS increased** from 12.1 to 14.9 days. ALOS is down 8% when comparing FY08 to FY09. **Commitments to ADJC remained constant** with 47 in May and June. **Intensive Probation decreased** from 448 to 442. **Standard probation counts** are currently undergoing data quality assurance. As a result, previously reported numbers may change.




# Average Daily Jail Population




# Average Daily Jail Population by Type



# Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail




# Average Length of Stay in Jail for Agency Holds





# Average Length of Stay in Jail Pretrial vs Sentenced Population




# Average Length of Stay in Jail for Pretrial Inmates


# Sheriff's Office Transports for Inmate Court Appearances





# Superior Court Filings and Terminations



# Active Pending Criminal Case Inventory




# Direct Complaints into Superior Court




# Status of Cases After 180 Days

# Disposition of Cases Terminated


Average monthly dispositions by quarter






# Grand Jury Indictments






# Pretrial Supervision Defendant Monitoring Unit



# Pretrial Supervision Defendants on Electronic Monitoring




# Adult Probation Standard Supervision Population



# Adult Probation Intensive Supervision Population




# Juvenile Detention Average Daily Population

# Juvenile Detention Average Length of Stay


