CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM Monthly Changes – June 2012

Adult Jail Incarceration

- **Bookings decreased** from 9,443 in May to 9,088 in June.
- The **Average Daily Population increased** from 7,792 in May to 7,903 in June.
- The **Pretrial Population increased** from 5,698 in May to 5,790 in June.
- The **Sentenced Population increased** from 1,881 in May to 1,907 in June.
- The **Agency Hold Population decreased slightly** from 166 in May to 158 in June.
- **Overall Average Length of Stay (ALOS) decreased** from 25.1 in May to 24.7 in June.
- The **ALOS for Sentenced increased** from 24.2 in May to 24.9 in June.
- The **ALOS for Pretrial decreased** from 7.05 in May to 6.9 in June.
- The **ALOS for Agency Holds increased** from 68.8 in May to 69 in June.

Superior Court Filings & Case Processing

- **New Criminal Case Filings decreased** from 3,306 in May to 2,755 in June.
- **Case Terminations decreased** from 2,373 in May to 2,467 in June.
- The resulting **Clearance Rate** was 89.5%.
- The **Active Pending Case Inventory decreased** from 11,564 in May to 11,412 in June.
- **Filings into Regional Court Center decreased** from 1,601 in May to 1,512 in June.
- **Filings into Early Disposition Court decreased** from 1,166 in May to 966 in June.
- The **Number of Trials Completed decreased** from 50 in May to 40 in June.
- The **Trial Rate** was 1.5%.

Justice Court Filings

- **DUI Filings decreased** from 799 in May to 787 in June.
- All other **Criminal Traffic Filings increased** from 3,693 in May to 3,998 in June.
- **Civil Traffic Filings increased** from 10,451 in May to 12,485 in June.
- **Eviction Action Filings increased** from 5,465 in May to 5,791 in June.
- **Overall Filings increased** from 30,486 in May to 32,343 in June.

Adult Probation


- **Pretrial Standard Supervision increased** from 2,069 in May to 2,493 in June.
- **Electronic Monitoring increased** from 314 in May to 422 in June.
- **Standard Probation Supervision decreased** from 21,652 in May to 21,611 in June.
- **Intensive Probation Supervision decreased** from 706 in May to 691 in June.
- **Unsupervised Probation Supervision increased** from 7,897 in May to 7,902 in June.

Juvenile Detention and Probation


- The **Average Daily Detention Population decreased** from 285 in May to 273 in June.
- **ALOS in juvenile detention increased** from 14.4 in May to 15.2 in June.
- **Standard probation decreased** from 2,559 in May to 2,504 in June.
- **Intensive Probation decreased** from 265 in May to 245 in June.
- **Monthly commitments to Arizona Department of Juvenile Corrections increased** from 35 in May to 40 in June.




Average Daily Jail Population




Average Daily Jail Population by Type




Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail



Average Length of Stay in Jail Pretrial vs Sentenced Population




Average Length of Stay in Jail for Agency Holds



Average Length of Stay in Jail for Pretrial Inmates




Sheriff's Office Transports for Inmate Court Appearances








Active Pending Criminal Case Inventory

Direct Complaints into Superior Court




Status of Cases After 180 Days






Superior Court Trials Completed




Disposition of Cases Terminated

Average Monthly Dispositions by Quarter




Grand Jury Indictments


Justice Court Average Monthly Filings by Quarter

■ Oct-Dec 2011





Pretrial Supervision Defendant Monitoring Unit Average Daily Standard Caseload



Pretrial Supervision Defendants on Electronic Monitoring




Adult Probation Standard Supervision Population



Adult Probation Intensive Supervision Population




Adult Probation Unsupervised Population



Juvenile Detention Average Daily Population




Juvenile Detention Average Length of Stay
