CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM Monthly Changes – March 2012

Adult Jail Incarceration

- **Bookings increased** from 8,204 in February to 8,717 in March.
- The **Average Daily Population decreased** from 7,387 in February to 7,367 in March.
- The **Pretrial Population increased** from 5,312 in February to 5,337 in March.
- The **Sentenced Population decreased** from 1,858 in February to 1,811 in March.
- The **Agency Hold Population stayed the same** at 167 in February and March.
- **Overall Average Length of Stay (ALOS) increased** from 24.3 days in February to 25.1 in March.
- The **ALOS for Sentenced decreased** from 26.2 days in February to 23.8 days in March.
- The **ALOS for Pretrial increased** from 6.9 days in February to 7.3 days in March.
- The **ALOS for Agency Holds increased** from 64 days in February to 67.7 days in March.

Superior Court Filings & Case Processing

- **New Criminal Case Filings increased** from 2,626 in February to 2,968 in March.
- **Case Terminations increased** from 2,419 in February to 2,908 in March.
- The resulting **Clearance Rate** was 98%.
- The **Active Pending Case Inventory decreased** from 11,098 in February to 11,033 in March.
- **Filings into Regional Court Center increased** from 1,341 in February to 1,546 in March.
- **Filings into Early Disposition Court increased** from 1,018 in February to 1,140 in March.
- The **Number of Trials Completed decreased** from 39 in February to 36 in March.
- The **Trial Rate** was 1.2%.

Justice Court Filings

- **DUI Filings increased** from 619 in February to 653 in March.
- All other **Criminal Traffic Filings increased** from 3,533 in February to 3,803 in March.
- **Civil Traffic Filings increased** from 10,331 in February to 10,947 in March.
- **Eviction Action Filings decreased** from 4,206 in February to 4,086 in March.
- **Overall Filings increased** from 28,750 in February to 29,043 in March.

Adult Probation


- **Pretrial Standard Supervision decreased** from 1,886 in February to 1,803 in March.
- **Electronic Monitoring increased** from 362 in February to 378 in March.
- **Standard Probation Supervision increased** from 21,656 in February to 21,659 in March.
- **Intensive Probation Supervision decreased** from 740 in February to 732 in March.
- **Unsupervised Probation Supervision decreased** from 8,075 in February to 8,072 in March.

Juvenile Detention and Probation


- The **Average Daily Detention Population decreased** from 248 in February to 229 in March.
- **ALOS in juvenile detention decreased** from 14.2 days in February to 14.1 days in March.
- **Standard probation decreased** from 2,677 in February to 2,676 in March.
- **Intensive Probation stayed the same** at 280 in February and March.
- Monthly **commitments to Arizona Department of Juvenile Corrections** increased from 35 in February to 39 in March.


Jail Bookings




Average Daily Jail Population




Average Daily Jail Population by Type




Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail



Average Length of Stay in Jail Pretrial vs Sentenced Population




Average Length of Stay in Jail for Agency Holds



Average Length of Stay in Jail for Pretrial Inmates




Sheriff's Office Transports for Inmate Court Appearances








Active Pending Criminal Case Inventory

Cases Arraigned




Direct Complaints into Superior Court




Status of Cases After 180 Days

Active Awaiting sentence Terminated




Superior Court Trials Completed




Disposition of Cases Terminated

Average Monthly Dispositions by Quarter




Grand Jury Indictments




Average Monthly Filings by Quarter

- Jan-Mar 2012





Pretrial Supervision Defendant Monitoring Unit Average Daily Standard Caseload



Pretrial Supervision Defendants on Electronic Monitoring




Adult Probation Standard Supervision Population




Standard and Unsupervised Probation populations were reported jointly under Standard prior to the July 2011 version of this report.

Adult Probation Intensive Supervision Population




Adult Probation Unsupervised Population



Juvenile Detention Average Daily Population




Juvenile Detention Average Length of Stay
