## *CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM NEWS – May 2009*

### Adult Incarceration

**Bookings increased** from 11,066 in April to 11,293 in May. The **Average Daily Population decreased** from 8,986 to 8,862. The **Pretrial Population decreased** in May (5,976) compared to April (6,152). The **Sentenced Population increased** to 2,477 in May compared to 2,442 in April. **Agency Hold Populations increased** from 331 in April to 352 in March. **Overall Average Length of Stay (ALOS) slightly increased** in May from 25.2 days to 25.8 days. **The ALOS for Sentenced decreased** from 24 to 23.1, while the **ALOS for Agency Holds increased** from 60.6 to 64. **Pretrial ALOS increased slightly** from 6.3 to 6.55.

### Superior Court Filings & Case Processing

**Criminal filings decreased** from April (3,101) to May (2,984). **Terminations decreased** to 2,967 in May from 3,410 in April. The resulting **Clearance Rate** was 99.4%. The **Active Pending Case Inventory decreased** from 11,214 in April to 10,963 in May. **Filings into RCC decreased** in May (1,731) compared to April (1,795). **Filings into EDC decreased** from 1,061 in April to 1,029 in May. The **Number of Trials Completed increased** from 86 in April to 95 in May. **The Trial Rate** was 3.2%.

### Justice Court Filings

**Forcible Detainer Filings increased** from April (5,172) to May (5,397). **Overall Filings decreased** from April (34,060) to May (31,745).

### Adult Probation

**Pretrial General Supervision decreased** from April (584) to May (538). **Pretrial Intensive Supervision decreased** from 1,062 in April to 987 in May. **Electronic Monitoring decreased** from 270 in April to 252 in May. Levels of **Standard Probation Supervision decreased** from 29,616 in April to 29,154 in May. **Levels of Intensive Probation Supervision also decreased** from 923 in April to 897 in May.


### Juvenile Detention and Probation

The **Average Daily Detention Population (ADP) decreased** from 291 in April to 289 in May. ADP is down 16% when comparing FY08 to FY09. **ALOS decreased** from 13.6 to 12.1 days. ALOS is down 9% when comparing FY08 to FY09. **Commitments to ADJC decreased** from 51 in April to 47 in May. **Standard probation decreased** from 4,220 in April to 4,117 in May. **Intensive Probation decreased** from 467 to 448.






# Average Daily Jail Population




# Average Daily Jail Population by Type



# Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail




# Average Length of Stay in Jail for Agency Holds





# Average Length of Stay in Jail Pretrial vs Sentenced Population




# Average Length of Stay in Jail for Pretrial Inmates


# Sheriff's Office Transports for Inmate Court Appearances







# Direct Complaints into Superior Court




# Grand Jury Indictments





# Superior Court Trials Completed




# Active Pending Criminal Case Inventory












# Status of Cases After 180 Days

Active Awaiting sentence Terminated




# Adult Probation Standard Supervision Population



# Adult Probation Intensive Supervision Population




# Juvenile Detention Average Daily Population

# Juvenile Detention Average Length of Stay


