CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM NEWS – May 2010

Adult Incarceration

Bookings increased from 10,075 in April to 10,296 in May. The **Average Daily Population decreased** from 7,938 in April to 7,817 in May. The **Pretrial Population decreased** in May (5,318) compared to April (5,453). The **Sentenced Population decreased slightly** from 2,138 in April to 2,134 in May. The **Agency Hold Population increased** from 294 in April to 314 in May. **Overall Average Length of Stay (ALOS) stayed the same** from April to May (24). **The ALOS for Sentenced increased** from 22.6 to 23.9 days, while the **Pretrial ALOS increased** from 5.7 to 5.9 days. The **ALOS for Agency Holds increased** from 60 to 63 days.

Superior Court Filings & Case Processing

Criminal Filings decreased from April (2,743) to May (2,577). **Terminations decreased** from 3,155 in April to 2,652 in May. The resulting **Clearance Rate** was 103%. The **Active Pending Case Inventory decreased** from 10,934 in April to 10,532 in May. **Filings into RCC decreased** in May (1,466) compared to April (1,662). **Filings into EDC increased** from 891 in April to 935 in May. The **Number of Trials Completed decreased** from 62 in April to 56 in May. **The Trial Rate** was 2.2%.

Justice Court Filings

DUI Filings decreased from April (838) to May (792). All other **Criminal Traffic Filings decreased** from 3,759 in April to 3,632 in May. **Civil Traffic Filings decreased** from 10,889 in April to 9,716 in May. **Civil Traffic Photo Enforcement Filings increased** from 29,359 in April to 36,789 in May. **Eviction Action Filings increased** from April (4,651) to May (4,979). **Overall Filings increased** from 61,337 in April to 68,302 in May.


Adult Probation

Pretrial General Supervision decreased from April (570) to May (552). **Pretrial Intensive Supervision decreased** from 850 in April to 782 in May. **Electronic Monitoring decreased slightly** from 215 in April to 208 in May. **Levels of Standard Probation Supervision decreased** from 30,368 in April to 30,316 in May. **Levels of Intensive Probation Supervision increased** from 804 in April to 818 in May.


Juvenile Detention and Probation

The **Average Daily Detention Population decreased** from 266 in April to 258 in May. **ALOS decreased** from 15.1 to 11.7 days. **Commitments to the Arizona Department of Juvenile Corrections decreased** from 39 in April to 26 in May. **Standard probation decreased** from 4,028 in April to 3,920 in May. **Intensive Probation decreased** from 373 in April to 359 in May.


Jail Bookings




Average Daily Jail Population




Average Daily Jail Population by Type



Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail




Average Length of Stay in Jail for Agency Holds




Average Length of Stay in Jail Pretrial vs Sentenced Population



Average Length of Stay in Jail for Pretrial Inmates




Sheriff's Office Transports for Inmate Court Appearances








Active Pending Criminal Case Inventory

Cases Arraigned




Direct Complaints into Superior Court




Status of Cases After 180 Days








Average Monthly Filings by Quarter




Pretrial Supervision Defendant Monitoring Unit



Pretrial Supervision Defendants on Electronic Monitoring




Adult Probation Standard Supervision Population



Adult Probation Intensive Supervision Population




Juvenile Detention Average Daily Population

Juvenile Detention Average Length of Stay


