### *CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM NEWS – October 2009*

#### **Adult Incarceration**

**Bookings decreased** from 10,459 in September to 10,287 in October. The **Average Daily Population decreased** from 8,493 to 8,449. The **Pretrial Population decreased** in October (5,736) compared to September (5,916). The **Sentenced Population increased** from 2,202 in September to 2,345 in October. The **Agency Hold Population decreased** from 315 in September to 309 in October. **Overall Average Length of Stay (ALOS) increased** from 24.8 days in September to 26.3 days in October. **The ALOS for Sentenced increased slightly** from 23.8 days to 24.3 days, while the **ALOS for Agency Holds increased** from 58.8 to 67.4 days. **Pretrial ALOS decreased** from 7.3 to 6.4 days.

#### **Superior Court Filings & Case Processing**

**Criminal Filings decreased** from September (2,908) to October (2,759). **Terminations increased** from 2,900 in September to 2,920 in October. The resulting **Clearance Rate** was 105.8%. The **Active Pending Case Inventory decreased** from 11,812 in September to 11,540 in October. **Filings into RCC decreased** in October (1,713) compared to September (1,802). **Filings into EDC decreased** from 880 in September to 860 in October. The **Number of Trials Completed increased slightly** from 66 in September to 69 in October. **The Trial Rate** was 2.5%.

#### **Justice Court Filings**

**Forcible Detainer Filings decreased** from September (5,881) to October (5,658). **Overall Filings** in October were 64,588 including 28,702 filings from Civil Traffic Photo Enforcement.


#### **Adult Probation**

**Pretrial General Supervision decreased slightly** from September (558) to October (554). **Pretrial Intensive Supervision decreased** from 927 in September to 868 in October. **Electronic Monitoring increased slightly** from 241 in September to 242 in October. **Levels of Standard Probation Supervision decreased** from 30,223 in September to 30,151 in October. **Levels of Intensive Probation Supervision increased slightly** from 819 in September to 820 in October.


#### **Juvenile Detention and Probation**

The **Average Daily Detention Population increased** from 244 in September to 262 in October. **ALOS decreased** from 12.1 to 11.7 days. **Commitments to ADJC decreased** from 42 in September to 33 in October. **Standard probation decreased** from 4,094 in September to 4,087 in October. **Intensive Probation increased** from 391 to 398.


# Jail Bookings




# Average Daily Jail Population




# Average Daily Jail Population by Type



# Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail




# Average Length of Stay in Jail for Agency Holds




# Average Length of Stay in Jail Pretrial vs Sentenced Population



# Average Length of Stay in Jail for Pretrial Inmates




# Sheriff's Office Transports for Inmate Court Appearances



Direct Filing began in May 2002




# Active Pending Criminal Case Inventory

Cases Arraigned




# Direct Complaints into Superior Court




# Status of Cases After 180 Days

# Disposition of Cases Terminated








# Grand Jury Indictments








# Pretrial Supervision Defendant Monitoring Unit



# Pretrial Supervision Defendants on Electronic Monitoring




# Adult Probation Standard Supervision Population



# Adult Probation Intensive Supervision Population




# Juvenile Detention Average Daily Population

# Juvenile Detention Average Length of Stay


