## ***CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM Monthly Changes – October 2015***

### **Adult Jail Incarceration**

- **Bookings decreased** from 8,609 in September to 7,957 in October.
- **Releases decreased** from 8,698 in September to 8,378 in October.
- The **Average Daily Population (ADP) decreased** from 8,178 in September to 7,886 in October.
- The **Pretrial ADP decreased** from 6,140 in September to 5,940 in October.
- The **Sentenced ADP decreased** from 1,812 in September to 1,733 in October.
- The **Agency Hold ADP decreased** from 180 in September to 172 in October.
- **Overall Average Length of Stay (ALOS) at release increased** from 27.5 in September to 30.2 in October.
- The **ALOS in days for Pretrial increased** from 8.3 in September to 10.9 in October.
- The **ALOS in days for Sentenced increased** from 22.4 in September to 22.5 in October.
- The **ALOS in days for Agency Holds increased** from 78 in September to 79 in October.

### **Superior Court Filings & Case Processing**

- **New Criminal Case Filings increased** from 2,453 in September to 2,482 in October.
- **Case Terminations decreased** from 2,576 in September to 2,533 in October.
- **The resulting Clearance Rate was 102%.**
- The **Active Pending Case Inventory decreased** from 11,127 in September to 10,700 in October.
- **Regional Court Center filings decreased** from 1,329 in September to 1,325 in October.
- **Early Disposition Court filings increased** from 834 in September to 841 in October.
- The **Number of Trials Completed decreased** from 56 in September to 46 in October.
- The **Trial Rate was 1.9%.**

### **Justice Court Filings**

- **DUI Filings decreased** from 772 in September to 535 in October.
- **All other Criminal Traffic Filings decreased** from 3,243 in September to 2,822 in October.
- **Civil Traffic Filings decreased** from 10,410 in September to 8,908 in October.
- **Eviction Action Filings decreased** from 5,572 in September to 5,378.
- **Total Filings decreased** from 28,780 in September to 25,521 in October.

### **Adult Probation**

- **Pretrial Standard Supervision increased** from 3,383 in September to 3,420 in October.
- **Pretrial Electronic Monitoring decreased** from 711 in September to 679 in October.
- **Adult Standard Probation Supervision increased** from 23,299 in September to 23,394 in October.
- **Adult Intensive Probation Supervision increased** from 1,036 in September to 1,084 in October.
- **Adult Unsupervised Probation Supervision decreased** from 4,726 in September to 4,774 in October.

### **Juvenile Detention and Probation**

- The **Average Daily Detention Population increased** from 155 in September to 169 in October.
- The **ALOS in juvenile detention increased** from 14.6 in September to 19.2 in October.
- **Juvenile Standard Probation decreased** from 1,849 in September to 1,815 in October.
- **Juvenile Intensive Probation increased** from 203 in September to 217 in October.
- **Monthly commitments to Arizona Department of Juvenile Corrections decreased** from 19 in September to 10 in October.





# Number of Dependency Petitions Filed Juvenile Court





# Recidivism Risk Score (RRS / "Proxy") Distribution Among Current Jail Population:










# Average Daily Jail Population



# Average Daily Jail Population by Type




# Average Daily Jail Population by Gender




# Average Daily Jail Population Charges by Gender within Specific Populations


## Pretrial Distribution




## Sentenced Distribution






# Pretrial Felony Average Daily Population




# Pretrial Misdemeanor Average Daily Population






# Average Daily Jail Population of City Offenders



# Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail at Release




# Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail In Custody\*




# Average Length of Stay in Jail Pretrial and Sentenced Inmates




# Average Length of Stay in Jail for Pretrial Inmates



## Average Length of Stay in Jail for Sentenced Inmates




# Average Length of Stay in Jail Agency Holds








# Superior Court Criminal Case Filings and Terminations




# Active Pending Criminal Case Inventory



# Status of Cases After 180 Days




# Disposition of Cases Terminated




# Grand Jury Indictments







# Justice Court Monthly Filings - Quarterly Average




# Pretrial Supervision Defendant Monitoring Unit Average Daily Standard Caseload






# Adult Probation Department Standard Supervision




# Adult Probation Intensive Supervision




# Adult Probation Unsupervised Population



# Juvenile Detention Average Daily Population




# Juvenile Detention Average Length of Stay




