CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM NEWS – SEPTEMBER 2006

Adult Incarceration

Bookings decreased from 10,925 in August to 10,566 in September. **Average Daily Population decreased** for the fifth month in a row, from 9,095 to 9,041. This is the lowest population since March 2005 (8,998). The **pretrial and hold populations decreased** from August to September; pretrial from 5,825 to 5,699 (which is the lowest since March 2005 when it was 5,657) and hold from 398 to 377. The **sentenced population increased** from 2,822 to 2,917.

Overall Average Length of Stay remained nearly the same at 25.7 days. **The ALOS measurement for agency holds increased** from 68.7 to 70.2 days. **Pretrial ALOS increased slightly** from 7.1 to 7.3 days, while **sentenced ALOS fell a day** from 30.9 to 29.9 days. Breaking down the pretrial population, felony ALOS increased from 10.3 to 11.3 days, while misdemeanor ALOS decreased from 3.5 to 3.0 days.

Superior Court Filings & Case Processing

Although criminal filings and terminations decreased in September (filings from 3,229 to 2,713 and terminations from 3,573 to 2,949), the termination rate remained high, at 108.7%. **The active pending case inventory decreased** from 10,719 to 10,249. **September filings into the RCC and EDC decreased.** RCC filings went from 1,820 to 1,621; these were the fewest filings since October 2005 – 1,610. EDC filings went from 1,053 to 725, the fewest filings since October 2004 - 636. **100 trials were completed in September**, compared to 90 in August. **The September trial rate was 3.7%, the highest monthly rate ever.**

Justice Court Filings

This information has been modified to reflect fiscal year averages as opposed to total numbers; also, some statistics have changed due to more accurate counts through iCIS. These changes are also part of the reason for the dramatic increases seen when comparing FY06 vs. FY07-to-date averages and September 2005 vs. September 2006.

Adult Probation


General pretrial supervision decreased from August's 928 to September's 885. The intensive and electronic monitoring populations increased: intensive from 1,183 to 1,202 and electronic from 229 to 236. **Levels of standard and intensive probation supervision increased** from August to September; standard from 29,791 to 29,930 and intensive from 1,258 to 1,283.

Juvenile Detention and Probation


The **Average Daily Detention Population slightly increased** from 403 in August to 405 in September. **ALOS decreased** from 17.9 to 16.1 days; this is the lowest ALOS since November 2005 – 16.0 days. **August Electronic Monitoring was 146**, compared to August's 136. **Home detention decreased** from 228 to 217, the lowest since September 2004 (216).

Levels of juvenile standard and intensive probation decreased slightly from August to September. Standard went from 4,352 to 4,326, while intensive went from 531 to 515.


Jail Bookings




Average Daily Jail Population



Average Daily Jail Population by Type




Average Length of Stay in Jail for Agency Holds




Average Length of Stay in Jail Pretrial vs Sentenced Population



Average Length of Stay in Jail for Pretrial Inmates




Sheriff's Office Transports for Inmate Court Appearances






Direct Filing began in May 2002



Direct Complaints into Superior Court




Grand Jury Indictments




Superior Court Trials Completed



Active Pending Criminal Case Inventory






Pretrial Supervision

Defendant Monitoring Unit




Pretrial Supervision Defendants on Electronic Monitoring




Disposition of Cases Terminated

Average monthly dispositions by quarter



Status of Cases After 180 Days




Adult Probation Standard Supervision Population




Adult Probation Intensive Supervision Population




Juvenile Detention Average Daily Population



Juvenile Detention Average Length of Stay




Juvenile Electronic Monitoring
