CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM NEWS – September 2009

Adult Incarceration

Bookings decreased from 10,926 in August to 10,459 in September. The **Average Daily Population increased** from 8,464 to 8,493. The **Pretrial Population increased slightly** in September (5,916) compared to August (5,888). The **Sentenced Population increased** from 2,196 in August to 2,202 in September. The **Agency Hold Population decreased** from 321 in August to 315 in September. **Overall Average Length of Stay (ALOS) increased** from 23.8 days in August to 24.8 in September. **The ALOS for Sentenced decreased slightly** from 23.8 days to 23.9 days, while the **ALOS for Agency Holds increased slightly** from 57.1 to 58.8 days. **Pretrial ALOS increased** from 6.7 to 7.3 days.

Superior Court Filings & Case Processing

Criminal Filings increased from August (2,864) to September (2,908). **Terminations increased** from 2,848 in August to 2,900 in September. The resulting **Clearance Rate** was 99.7%. The **Active Pending Case Inventory decreased slightly** from 11,835 in August to 11,812 in September. **Filings into RCC decreased slightly** in September (1,802) compared to August (1,805). **Filings into EDC increased** from 755 in August to 880 in September. The **Number of Trials Completed decreased slightly** from 70 in August to 66 in September. **The Trial Rate** was 2.3%.

Justice Court Filings

Forcible Detainer Filings decreased from August (5,947) to September (5,881). **Overall Filings** in September were 65,793 including 30,296 filings from Civil Traffic Photo Enforcement.


Adult Probation

Pretrial General Supervision increased slightly from August (540) to September (558). **Pretrial Intensive Supervision decreased slightly** from 929 in August to 927 in September. **Electronic Monitoring decreased slightly** from 245 in August to 241 in September. Levels of **Standard Probation Supervision increased** from 30,181 in August to 30,223 in September. **Levels of Intensive Probation Supervision decreased** from 841 in August to 819 in September.


Juvenile Detention and Probation

The **Average Daily Detention Population increased** from 237 in August to 244 in September. **ALOS remained essentially the same** from 12.0 to 12.1 days. **Commitments to ADJC increased slightly** from 36 in August to 42 in September. **Intensive Probation decreased slightly** from 400 to 391. **Standard probation decreased slightly** from 4,106 in August to 4,094 in September.


Jail Bookings




Average Daily Jail Population




Average Daily Jail Population by Type



Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail




Average Length of Stay in Jail for Agency Holds




Average Length of Stay in Jail Pretrial vs Sentenced Population



Average Length of Stay in Jail for Pretrial Inmates




Sheriff's Office Transports for Inmate Court Appearances



Direct Filing began in May 2002




Active Pending Criminal Case Inventory

Cases Arraigned




Direct Complaints into Superior Court




Status of Cases After 180 Days

Active Awaiting sentence Terminated




Superior Court Trials Completed




Disposition of Cases Terminated

Average monthly dispositions by quarter




Grand Jury Indictments






Pretrial Supervision Defendant Monitoring Unit



Pretrial Supervision Defendants on Electronic Monitoring




Adult Probation Standard Supervision Population



Adult Probation Intensive Supervision Population




Juvenile Detention Average Daily Population

Juvenile Detention Average Length of Stay


